



# North Kenton Park

This project involved excavating and reshaping an existing earth mound, installing new play equipment, creating new footpaths and landscaping.

The recreation area was very restricted and the budget restrictions set the philosophy of no materials were to leave site and importation had to be kept to an absolute minimum; therefore, by working very closely with the Landscape Architect, the final layout was designed to accommodate these parameters.

The play equipment included using existing boulders, tree trunks as low level bridges, climbing cones, overhead swings and a play fort.

The footpaths were informally created with wood chip.

The safety surfaces were formed with play grade woodchips.

Along with newly constructed earth mounds, the play area became a natural adventure ground.
