



Play Pathfinder Scheme Newcastle

This project comprised of seven different sites, some at distances of 5 miles from each other.

The scope of works included, removing existing play equipment, re-shaping the ground to form play mounds and re-profiling the embankment slopes, installing play equipment and natural play pieces such as boulders, boulder stacks, 4m high timber poles and felled trees, laying new play surfaces such as safety matting, wood chippings and sand.

These works were carried out in conjunction with each other and were managed to optimise efficient use of resources. Some of the equipment and features were unique in nature and in collaboration with the Landscape Architect, we were able to furnish play areas which provided the concepts the Architect was endeavouring to achieve within very tight budgets.

By working closely with the Client to fully understand the projects inherent challenges, we were able to successfully hand over the high quality project to the standards set by RoSPA.

Despite undertaking these schemes in the worse winter weather for 30 years, they were completed on time, within budget and without any safety incidents.
