



Pegswood Changing Facilities

This project involved the construction of a new changing pavilion within the existing Pegswood welfare centre grounds.

The works included the construction of a raft foundation outer shell and internal pavilion walls using forticrete architectural masonry blocks, a metsec purlin monopitch roof structure with a kingspan roof covering. The building structure was completed with robust fittings and fixtures, services and finishing's to provide long term, low maintenance and optimum performance.

Upon completion an access road was constructed to a standard capable of accommodating all emergency service appliances, the existing pavilion was demolished and the surrounding area landscaped.

By working closely with the Client and his professional team, NCS were able to make a positive contribution to the development of an appropriate scope of works and then successfully deliver a high quality project on time, within an agreed budget and without any safety incidents.
