



Pelton Fell Band Room

The project comprised of the construction of a Band Room for the NASUWT Riverside Band. The building was a single storey extension to an existing single story brickwork structure. Partial demolition was required, including the removal of the existing roof. The outer skin was facing brick work and the internal walls plaster board. The new roof was to be supported by steel beams and comprised of salvaged tiles and plywood sheeting with a steel lining. External works included the installation of drainage.

The building was within a leisure park which was open to the public therefore strict health and safety regime was adhered to in order to protect the public. Entrance to the site was via the busy main road and management of vehicles was of utmost importance.

Works were completed on time within budget, with no safety incidents and to the Client and end users satisfaction.
